

3. Community Foundation-Fall Food insecurity grant submitted for \$25,000-Community Foundation wants to fund groups that are healthy. We don't know if we will get any money but we fit the criteria.

New Business:

-Reminder: Elections in December

1. MNC updates:
 - a. We did just gather clothing for a refugee family in Oneonta. Four children, two adults. A mom and daughter are coming as well. Dr. Hodgen is volunteering.

2. Currently 90 children-ready to send information out to donors.
 - a. Looking at the second week of December for drop off.
 - b. Trying to confirm date and time with a local church.

3. SNAP benefits shortfall fundraiser
 - a. Do we want to do an ask online or do a direct giving fundraiser?
 - b. In favor of doing the fundraiser but it's a lot of fundraising all at once-SNAP, Thanksgiving, Christmas.
 - c. Matt suggested that we do SNAP and Thanksgiving now for a week or two and then come back on giving Tuesday for Christmas assistance.
 - d. Erin and Alicia will get an ask out for food insecurity tomorrow and we will look into other payment sites before December that might cover the fee (square doesn't allow donors to cover the fee).
 - e. Should we set a goal? Thanksgiving cost \$4400 last year-We like the idea of having a giving thermometer
 - f. Matt figured out that we still have a Cheddar Up account-should we use it again?
4. Thanksgiving-Should we give backpack kids a Thanksgiving card without them having to ask?
 - a. 10 kids in elementary and 8 in HS
 - b. Have not done that in the past because we don't want to be redundant.
 - c. Group thinks it might be redundant and suggests that families still request. Will send email out to families by the 10th so we can make sure everyone is covered.
5. We are in the process of reviewing the Bylaws. **A revised version will be voted on in December. Please review in the next two 2 weeks/email with suggestions changes by November 17**
6. Matt brought up Fire and Liability Insurance. We need to pay it for another year. \$456 for Liability and Fire-Laurie motions, Erin Seconds-Motion carries
7. Online Auction for timeshare-when to do it? The auction site works. Erin did mock up for graphics. Does around Thanksgiving make sense? Consensus is to start it on Black Friday and run it until December 7.

8. Funding Requests:
