1.) Welcome/Introductions

2.) Approval of January Meeting Minutes -Laurie Motions, Matt Seconds. Motion carries.

3.) Treasurers Report:

The total of \$9,590.00 for holiday donations that Matt reported last meeting had a deposit date in January, so it is reflected in this month's balance.

4.) Funding Requests:

a.) 5 students shared they needed help with the cost of the Cotillion Fee. Of those, 2 are current AN families and have requested assistance.

i.) Continue discussion about funding a lump sum amount or providing assistance to only those who completed the request form- the 2 AN families

Conversation on lump sum versus funding 80% of tuition for all students. Five students requested funding, but only one filled out the family request form. The group decided to fund the students individually but only if the family fills out the form.

We will ask for clothing at a later time. And support paying for something new if needed.

Marcie motions, Gretchen seconds. So moved.

b.) A family has requested assistance to pay the balance of a phone and wifi. No income, at this time no plan to be able to sustain the bill but would like to get it turned back on. Student is a kindergartener, no work to be done at home via computer at this time. Family has 6 phones on a cellular plan. This is not their main phone line.

The group asked for more information as the student doesn't need wifi at this time. It isn't a safety issue at this time. What is the group fulfilling? There doesn't seem to be a need.

c.) High School student has a change in circumstance and is currently acting as their own guardian. Guidance is requesting help with gas and groceries for student. While the guidance office has \$75 cards for gas and \$100 cards for groceries, this student will be supporting self and sibling. One of each card available at school has been provided. As this need will be ongoing for a bit, we have been asked if we could provide a card for each in a larger amount. I would like to start the request at \$200 gas and \$500 groceries.

This is an emergent need that is developing. Guidance is trying to figure out how to best support the student. Let guidance parse out the gas and grocery cards.

Matt motions 5 \$100 groceries and 3 \$50 gas cards-Marcie seconds-Motion carries

There may be college needs in the future.
